Dinner & Pep Rally at Auld Pavilion/Early Check-in for Dinner Participants

Join us at the Auld Pavilion in Antelope Park at 6:30 p.m. for this year’s Friday night dinner and pep rally. This year, we will celebrate the 40th anniversary of women in the band. The Auld Pavilion provides a beautiful ballroom atmosphere for our event, with seating for up to 250 people.

It will be a casual, family friendly evening, and we encourage you to bring your children. (The pavilion is located adjacent to the Antelope Park playground.) The evening promises to provide you with great opportunities to enjoy conversations with old friends and meet alumni from different eras. Cornhusker Marching Band staff will bring us news about the School of Music and the current band. This year’s event will be catered by one of Lincoln’s finest caterers, Tastefully Yours. The menu will feature bbq chicken, pork, a variety of side dishes, and dessert. The price is \$15.00 for adults, \$7.00 for children ages 3-12, and free for children 2 and under. The event will begin at 6:30 p.m. with time for socializing and cold drinks. Dinner will be served at 7:00. The event will conclude by 8:30.

As an added incentive to attend, Friday night dinner participants can check-in and receive your music, field pass, and football tickets on Friday night, saving you time on Saturday. We hope as many of you as possible will join us for this great kickoff to our weekend together.

All marching alumni are required to wear an all red shirt, khaki pants/shorts, and white socks and shoes to perform at the football game on Saturday. Flag line/color guard participants will wear a black shirt.

Check-in at Westbrook Music Building

Westbrook Music Building (WMB) will open in the morning for check-in, where you will receive your registration packet, which includes your music and field pass. If you purchased a football ticket, you may also pick it up.

Instrument Rental Policy

The UNL Band Department has a limited number of instruments available for the reunion weekend. Instruments can be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis on the reunion weekend registration form. Clarinets, alto saxophones, trumpets, and trombones are not available for rental. Recently, your band alumni association assumed the costs associated for repairs and maintenance of the university owned instruments used for the reunion weekend. Thanks to the generous support and work of Chuck Teutsch, several instruments have already been restored to near new condition over the past several months. To keep these instruments in good working order, we have instituted a \$25 per instrument rental fee.

Indoor Rehearsal at Westbrook Music Building

We will begin the day with an indoor rehearsal at Westbrook to practice the music. Flag line/color guard members will go to Memorial Stadium after they receive their registration packet to meet with the captain/rank leaders of the current color guard to learn the routine while the alumni band rehearses indoors.

BAA Annual Meeting

The annual meeting of the UNL Band Alumni Association will be held during the reunion weekend between the outdoor rehearsal and departure for the stadium. The meeting will be held in Westbrook Music Building. If you would like to attend the meeting but are unable to march at the game, please contact Board General Manager/Executive Secretary, Kevin Nelson, by September 1st, so you can be added to the security list at Westbrook Music Building.

Field Rehearsal

Following indoor rehearsal, we will meet with the current band at Memorial Stadium. Here we will practice the entrance and exit from the field for halftime, as well as practice our music with the current band. This rehearsal should last about one hour. You will be on your own until we meet back at WMB for a final rehearsal.

Business Meeting and Rehearsal

We will meet back in room 130 of WMB for our annual business meeting and a final rehearsal of the music. Following the meeting and rehearsal, we will line up in front of WMB to march down to Memorial Stadium.

Reunion Football Ticket Policy

The band alumni association has a limited number of tickets available on a first-come, first-served basis. The block of tickets is in the southwest corner of Memorial Stadium. While you will not be sitting with the alumni band, you will be sitting with other band alumni, spouses, etc. These tickets are available only to current members who have registered for the reunion weekend. If you are marching you don't need a ticket, but you may reserve on ticket for a guest. If you have a need for more than one ticket, you may e-mail the board and request no more than two tickets. If you would like to request additional tickets or have questions regarding the ticket policy, please contact Board General Manager/Executive Secretary, Kevin Nelson (see board contact information on page 2)

Game and Performance

When not performing, the Alumni Band will sit on the sidelines on the East side of the field. We will work with the Band and Athletic departments to be able to play a couple of times during the game, but please be aware that this may not be possible. Each game is scripted as to what is played on Husker Vision and when the band can play. Please be aware that because of increased security at all University events, only performing alumni will be able to sit on the sidelines. Performing alumni will be issued a lanyard with a field pass with their registration packet. **YOU MUST WEAR YOUR FIELD PASS AT ALL TIMES!** Any person sitting with the Alumni Band without a field pass will be asked to leave immediately by Memorial Stadium Security. Non-performing alumni, spouses, children, or guests **MUST** pay for a ticket and sit in the stands. As a reminder, when you participate with the Alumni Band, you agree to abide by the bylaws of the UNL Band Alumni Association, Inc., and the rules of the University of Nebraska-Lincoln relating to conduct in Memorial Stadium. If you fail to follow the University rules, you could be asked to leave the stadium. Please note that the University of Nebraska-Lincoln reserves the right to examine the contents of any container brought into the stadium. The following items are prohibited: alcoholic beverages or controlled substances; coolers, large bags and backpacks; noise makers; glass bottles and cans; video cameras; banners/flags on poles (except for you flag line alumni); and open umbrellas. If you are able, you are asked to stay at the game until its conclusion and march back to Westbrook with the Alumni Band.

Deadlines

The deadline for online registration is 10:00pm CDT, September 1, 2012 OR if by mail, postmarked by August 24, 2012. **NO late registrations will be accepted. NO walk-ins are allowed, and NO phone reservations will be taken.** Because of security concerns with the handling and safety of money on game day, we are no longer able to accept payment when you arrive.

PLEASE don't miss your chance to participate by missing the deadline! The deadline is not just for us, but for all departments involved in the planning and preparation of this reunion. The deadline is necessary for processing all memberships and reunion registrations. We also must meet a deadline with the Band Office for the arrangement of music and charting of marching members and with the Athletic Department to ensure we have enough seating on the sideline for the game. **NO WALK-IN OR LATE REGISTRATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

All alumni who register to attend the reunion will receive an e-mail confirmation with the schedule and exact times prior to the reunion weekend. That information will also be posted on our website: <http://www.nebandalums.org>.

Post-Game Party at the Apothecary Loft

Following the football game and performance, all alumni and guests are invited to participate in the post-game party at the Apothecary Loft at 140 N. 8th St. in the Haymarket. Your advance registration of \$5.00/person covers your admission, Runzas, Valentino's pizza, soda, and water. The Apothecary Loft is a beautiful, comfortable facility. It is a great opportunity to continue socializing. Cable TV is available for those who want to keep abreast of the other football games of the day.
